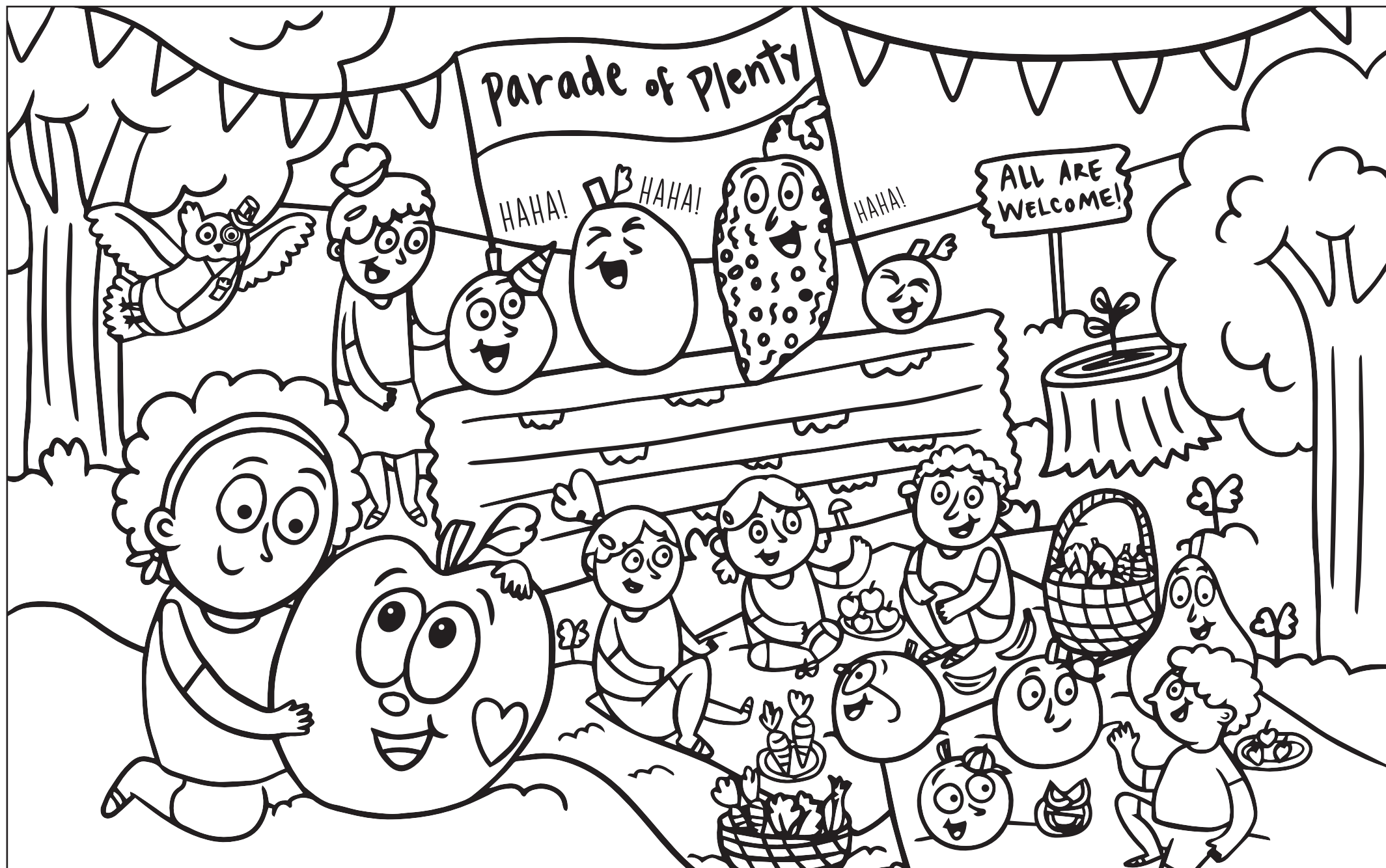

WORDSEARCH: THERE'S ENOUGH.

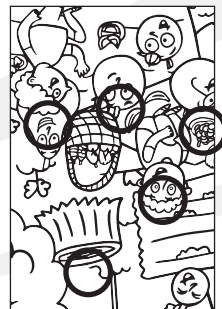

HIDE THE SWEET!

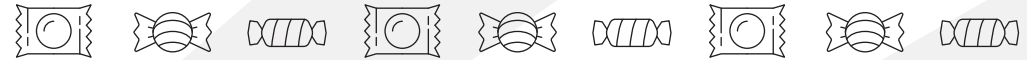


For this game you'll need a packet of sweets, 2 or more cups and a group of friends to play with.

HAVE A PIECE-A PIZZA GAME

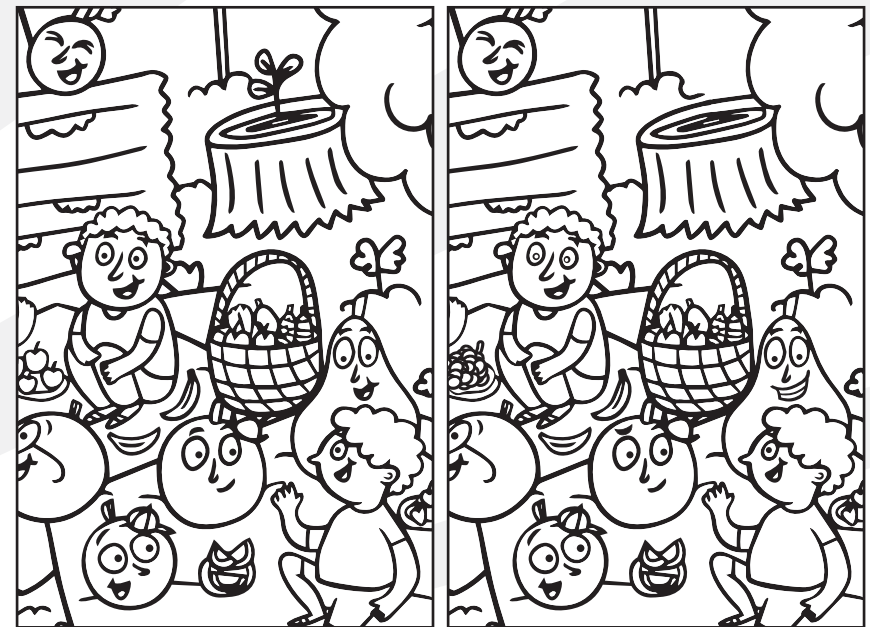
What you need:

- A cooked pizza to share
- Dice

When you next have a pizza at home, have it sliced into different sized slices – some bigger and some smaller. One at a time roll the dice, the person with the highest score gets to choose their piece-a pizza first, down to the lowest score until you each have a piece. Chat about how it felt.

Were you left hungry having just a teeny piece? Did you feel bad being able to choose the biggest slice? Would it have been better if the pizza had been cut into equal slices and why?
